




This building was the Stroud Hotel and Tipp's Men's Apparel once made its home on the 1st floor.

This recently added mosaic decorates the sign for a beloved historic building constructed in 1928.






This building provided entertainment for many generations.

This building once housed a sporting goods store that was known as the local museum because the owner, Mr. Watson, displayed animals he had hunted around the world.







This building has been home to several barber shops and cafes.




This building once housed a restaurant and a variety store.
